One of the most wonderful things about living in New Orleans is that we truly live the liturgical year; in fact, the presence of it outweighs, in many ways, the calendar year. Most of our folks at St. Andrew's love Lent. Having partied and paraded and rejoiced in the Epiphany explosion of the Light of Christ, we are ready to enter a quieter season, a more reflective time, a time of deepening of our relationship with Christ. Welcome to Lent!

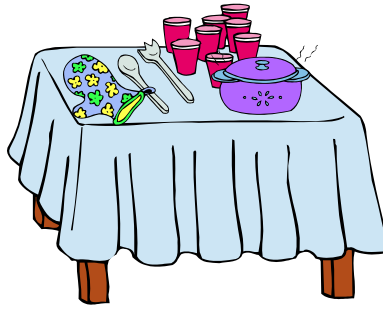
On the first day of Lent, Ash Wednesday, we are reminded that we are mortal; every one of us will depart in death from this earthly pilgrimage. That is a sobering thought, especially to the young. Imposing ashes on an infant is heartbreaking for me, but we all do die so it is important. Wearing the ashes is not a mark of pride, but rather a reminder of how precious and frail our lives really are.

We are also reminded to keep a Holy Lent, not in an ostentatious way, but in a quiet unobservable way, not to impress, but to open ourselves to be repossessed by God. This is not an easy thing for most of us to do--to give ourselves over to Christ as penitent individuals seeking forgiveness and to live into God's better ways. Giving up something can lead us into a more sacrificial life. Doing something challenging, especially if it involves helping others, can be equally life-giving. To ignore the potential Lent offers us to grow closer to God is truly a sin. Easter will mean far less if Lent is not observed.

During Lent at St. Andrew's this year we are all invited to attend at least one potluck supper at a parishioner's home and to partake of Holy Communion there. Members of our parish who are active in ongoing outreach ministries will be invited to tell us more about their own spiritual journeys and how they have grown as Disciples of Christ because of those ministries. Attached you will find a list of hosting homes and speakers. Everyone is invited; age makes no difference. Just let us know in the Office which evening(s) you plan to attend and what you might bring. Note that we have planned these evenings on different days of the week, so everyone can be included. The session at the Millers will offer a special activity for children. Every session will begin at 6 pm and end at 8 pm.. This is a time to get to know the members of your parish better and to share the love of Christ with them.

May you keep a meaningful and most holy Lent this year. Blessings to all,

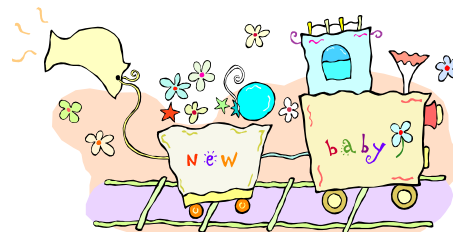

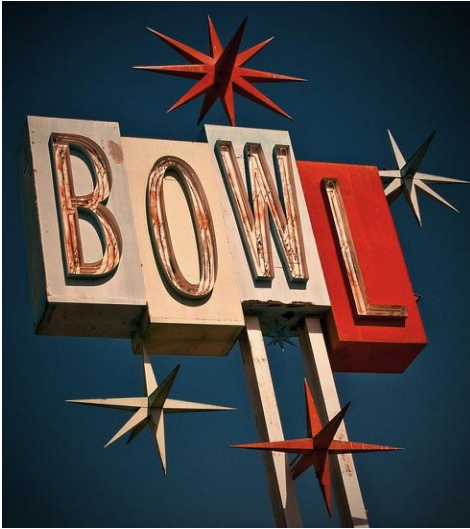
